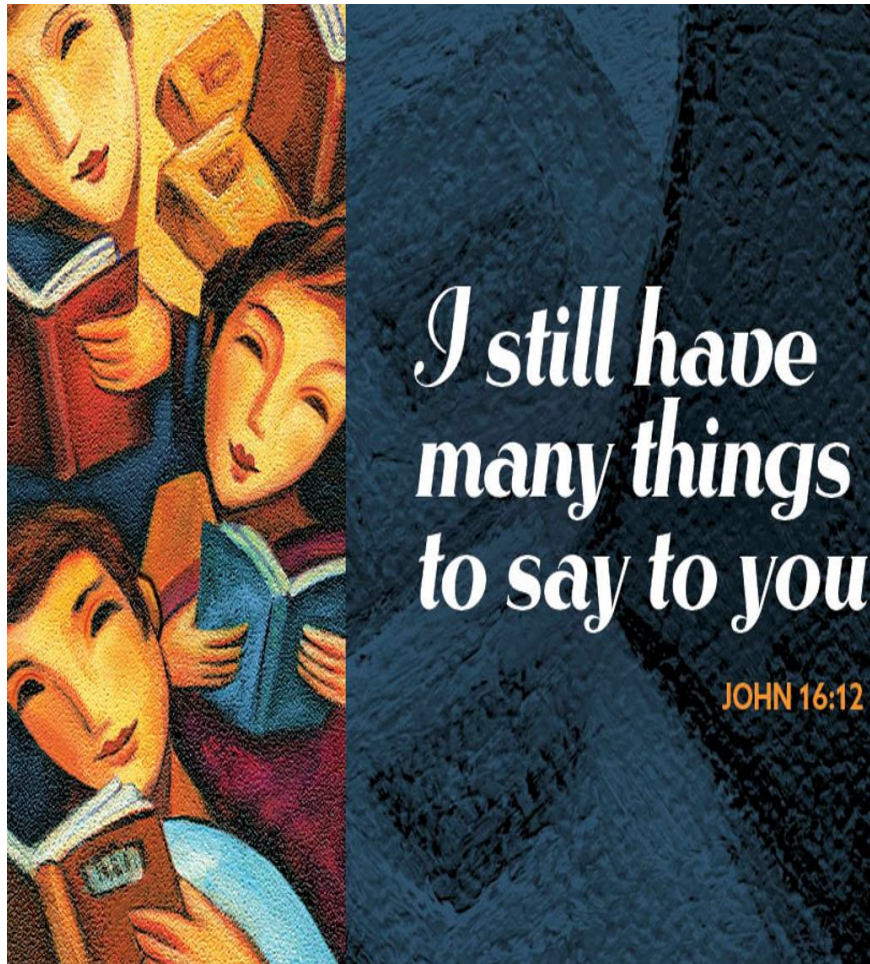

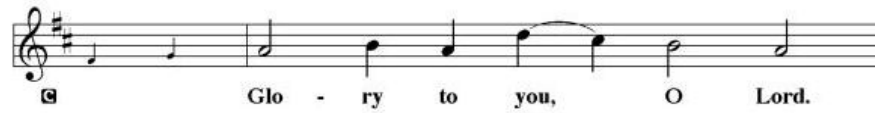
Romans 5:1-5

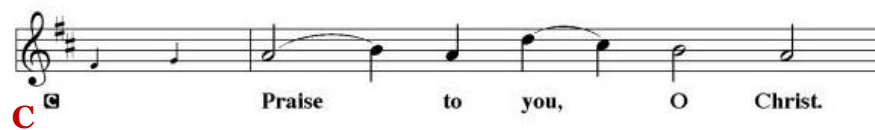


**P The Holy Gospel According to St. John, the
