Have a great rest of the summer and look to see you all back soon. pjh

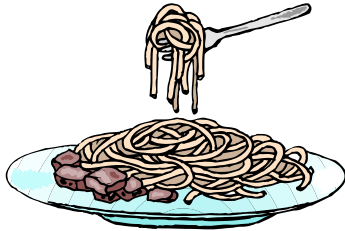
